## Affirmative (+)

I am I'm

You are You're

He/She/It is He's/She's/It's We/They are We're/They're

## Negative (-)

He/She/It is not

I am not I'm not

You are not You aren't

We/They are not We/They aren't

He/She/It isn't

## **USE**

It's used to talk about personal information. feelings and emotios, states, locations and qualities.

## Examples

I am Jack. I'm fifteen. You are so beautiful. He is a singer. They are at school.

## Questions

Am I in class?
Are you at home?
Is he/she/it tired?

Are we/you/they busy?

## Short Answers

Yes, I am.

No, I am not.

Yes, you are.

No, you aren't.

Yes, he/she/it is. No, he/she/it isn't.

Yes, we/you/they No, we/you/they

are. aren't.

## Subject pronouns

Singular	l <sup>o</sup> I	уо

Plural	l <sup>o</sup> we	nosotros

Pronouns replace nouns.

They are the subject of the sentence.

# PRESENT SIMPLE

We use the Present Simple for general facts, habits, and routines.

POSITIVE	NEGATIVE	QUESTION
I / You / We / They play.	I / You / We / They <b>don't</b> play.	<b>Do</b> I / you / we / they play? Yes, I / you / we / they <b>do.</b> No, I / you / we / they <b>don't.</b>
He / She / It play <b>s</b> .	He / She / It <b>doesn't</b> play.	<b>Does</b> he / she / it play? Yes, he / she / it <b>does</b> . No, he / she / it <b>doesn't</b> .

## SPELLING RULES for the 3rd person singular (HE/SHE/IT)

Basic Rule

Most verbs: Just add -s

Example: He plays, She reads, It rains

E Special Endings

Verbs ending in -ss, -x, -ch, -sh, or -o:

Add -es.

For example:

He kisses (kiss)

She watches (watch)

It goes (go)

He fixes (fix)

abc Verbs ending in consonant + y

Change the -y to -ies

Examples:

She studies (study)

He flies (fly)

It cries (cry)

But if the verb ends in a vowel + y,

just add -s:

He plays (play)

# PRESENT CONTINUOUS

We use the Present Continuous for actions happening **now**.

POSITIVE	NEGATIVE	QUESTION
I <b>am</b> playing.	I <b>am not</b> playing	<b>Am</b> I playing? Yes, I <b>am</b> . No, I' <b>m not</b> .
He / She / It <b>is</b> playing.	He / She / It <b>isn't</b> playing	Is he / she / it playing? Yes, he / she / it is. No, he / she / it isn't.
We / You / They <b>are</b> playing.	We / You / They <b>aren't</b> playing	Are we / you / they playing? Yes, we / you / they are. No, we / you / they aren't.

## -ING SPELLING RULES

## **General Rule**

In general we just add-ING to the end of a verb.

- eat 
   ⇒ eating
- ⇒ going @ go
- read ⇒ reading

## Consonant + Vowel + Consonant

When a verb with one syllable ends in a C+V+C we double the final consonant.

- → cutting 2 cut
- running 2 run
- stop 
   → stopping

## Verbs ending in Consonant + E

Remove the E from the end of the verb and add -ING.

- dance dancing
- ride → riding
- write → writing

## Verbs ending in IE

Remove the IE from the end of the verb and add -YING.

- tie ⇒ tying

 die ⇒ dying lie ⇒ lying



# PAST SIMPLE

We use the Past Simple to talk about finished actions in the past.

POSITIVE	NEGATIVE	QUESTION
I / You / He / She/ It / We / They <b>walked</b> to school.	I / You / He / She/ It / We / They <b>didn't walk</b> to school.	Did I / you / he / she/ it / we / they walk to school?  Yes, I / you / he / she/ it / we / they did.  No, I / you / he / she/ it / we / they didn't.

## Regular verbs

Add -ed to the base form: play → play**ed** work → worked



## Spelling rules:

• Verbs ending in -e: add -d

love → love**d** 

- Verbs ending in consonant + u: change u to i + ed study → studied
- One-syllable verbs ending in vowel + consonant: double the consonant stop → stopped

## Irregular verbs

These don't follow a pattern and must be memorized:

go → went

buy → bought

eat → **ate** 

### WH-Questions Structure

## WH-word + did + subject + base verb

What did you do yesterday?

Where did he travel last summer?

Why did they cancel the meeting?

Remember: the verb stays in its base form after "did" - no -ed or irregular forms!
